How to Submit Your Title and Abstract:

- Please review the Presentation Criteria below on what is expected of your presentation.
- Submit a title and abstract in an email to conference@anylogic.com for submission with the subject: [Presenter Inquiry for AnyLogic Conference 2026](#).
- Please keep your abstract under 300 words.

Presentation Criteria:

Presentations should be approximately 20–25 minutes, with an additional 5–10 minutes allotted for Q&A. To keep strong audience engagement, we recommend that you provide 2–3 “loaded” questions that will be initiated by an AnyLogic team member in the circumstance that the audience does not provide any questions. The content of the presentation should include:

1. Executive summary of the case study to support the abstract submitted.
2. Business challenge solved.
3. Why you chose AnyLogic.
4. Why your work is significant:
 - a) Tangible benefit achieved (numbers or evidence recommended).
 - b) Intangible benefit realized.
5. Show the AnyLogic model.
6. Q & A.

Publication Release:

All conference presentations will be recorded and utilized for AnyLogic publications. As a condition of being a Presenter, please note the following:

- Your company Logo (and client's Logo, if applicable) will be utilized for the promotion of the Conference.
- Your individual presentation, although live in a virtual setting, will be recorded and made available via the AnyLogic Website.
- Your presentation itself will be made available for download via The AnyLogic Website.
- Your recorded presentation and materials will be converted into a case study for further publishing and repurposing.
- You must have permission to use all images/videos in your presentation. This includes any 3rd-party images/videos.
